Mr. Salazar has experience in advising clients on complex issues arising from public finance transactions, as well as on the formation of community facilities districts, election procedures, federal and state tax issues, and contract negotiation.

In his public finance practice, Mr. Salazar has represented local governments in financing community facilities, public facilities, including a city library, and water facilities. Mr. Salazar has structured, negotiated and drafted a variety of bond and security documents, including leases, trust indentures, fiscal agent agreements, and escrow agreements.

Prior to joining the firm, Mr. Salazar was in-house counsel for a boutique equipment leasing and finance company based in Los Angeles. He attended law school with the company's support to transition from intern and law clerk to full time counsel. While in law school, Mr. Salazar gained considerable legal experience as an extern for the Honorable Richard M. Neiter in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California, and as a legal summer associate for a private equity firm in Beverly Hills. Mr. Salazar served as a Lead Article Editor for the Journal of International Law, and his article titled "Swapping More than Regulations: Reexamining the Goals of Dodd-Frank and EMIR on Over-the-Counter Derivative Markets" was selected for publication.
